**WHITE HEAT PRESENTS SPECIAL GUEST ARTISTS FOR WEDNESDAY 'DANCING UNDER THE STARS' SWING SERIES AT THE BOSTON HARBOR HOTEL**

**NEWS: EULA LAWRENCE SINGS AUG 8 07:** Eula Lawrence has sung with jazz greats such as pianist, McCoy Tyner and is well known as Boston's First Lady of Song, for her beautiful treatment of Gershwin, Cole Porter and other contributors to the Great American Song Book. She was a featured artist at the Boston Globe Jazz Festival, and also starred in the show, Cole to Cole, a tribute to Nat King Cole and Natalie Cole at the Lyric Theater.

The floating music stage at the Boston Harbor Hotel has been the scene for romantic sunsets and energetic swing dancing to Boston's most notable swing band, the White Heat Swing Orchestra Wednesdays since June 27 2007. WHSO performs every Wednesday from 6-10pm with sets at 6, 7:30 and 9pm. Each Wednesday features a special guest vocalist and big band era theme. WHSO is the Boston-based swing band that backed up Norah Jones at Lincoln Center, Tony Bennett at the Roxy, and recorded for Warner Brother and Walt Disney.

**NEWS:** Aug 15 2007 Al Jobz is the featured guest artist. Craig Ball and WHSO will present a tribute to Artie Shaw in the second set. Al is the founder and leader of one of greater New England's most sought after show bands, Take Five and the Uptown Brass. He worked regularly with Paul O'Donnell, the well-known South Boston comic who wrote "Charlie on the MTA". A tribute to Artie Shaw will include Begin the Beguine and Star Dust plus rarer Shaw material such as the "killer diller" Traffic Jam, the Carioca and a special WHSO arrangement of Back Bay Shuffle.
